Elizabeth E. Wagner, Ph.D., is a private practitioner specializing in DBT, CBT, and mindfulness with adolescents and adults. Dr. Wagner is on faculty in the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences at Montefiore Medical Center/Albert Einstein College of Medicine in New York City. From 2001-2004, Dr. Wagner served as Assistant Director of Montefiore's Adolescent Depression and Suicide Program where she conducted and supervised DBT and CBT with teenagers and their families. From 1999-2001 she was co-investigator on a grant developing an adaptation of DBT for a triply diagnosed population (HIV-positive, substance abusing, with BPD) and attending psychologist in the Department of Surgery where she conducted pre-surgical psychological evaluations and supervised DBT skills training groups for bariatric surgery patients.
